Students' Code of Conduct

- 1. The first lecture will begin with a prayer. A six day time-table is strictly followed in the college. Every student should enter the class before the prayer bell rings. The students shall stand in attention till the prayer ends. Those who are standing outside the classroom are also expected to follow this.
- 2. Smoking or using chewing gum, pan-gutakha is strictly prohibited.
- 3. No students shall wander or gather in corridor or on staircase when the classes are being conducted.
- 4. All the students shall wear their identity cards, well displayed and the college staff shall have the right to examine it. Denial of that will invite disciplinary action.
- 5. This is an esteemed institute. Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline and dignified manner of behaviour inside as well as on the College campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the College. Damaging the college property leads to punishment and fine.
- 6. Keep the campus neat and clean. Put the waste only in the waste baskets.
- 7. It is mandatory for every student to appear in the internal test exam conducted at the end of every semester. Those who fail to score the minimum qualifying marks will be debarred from the university examination. They have to occupy the seat 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 8. Harassing juniors, ill treatment to other fellow students or any such form of ragging is objectionable and liable to be treated as a criminal offence.
- 9. Students are not permitted to arrange any unauthorized celebrations in the campus.
